Response to Reviewer 1 (reviewer code: 4737837):

Well written manuscript of a very case.

Comments 1 Are the authors able to describe the parts of the duodenum as first, second, third and fourth parts in their description of the pathology noted intraoperatively.

Answer: We are really appreciated your helpful comments. During the operation, it was found that the ascending part of the duodenum inserted into the junction of the horizontal part of the duodenum and the descending part (Figure 3A). Separate intussusception and cut open the intestinal wall, there was a pedicled tumor in the horizontal part of the duodenum near the ascending part, and the size of the tumor was approximately 5.0 cm*3.5 cm (Figure 3B, C) .Complete resection of the mass by 1cm from the edge of the tumor

Comments 2. Arrows would be good to illustrate the pathology on the images provided
