Abstract

BACKGROUND

Glomus tumors (GTs), defined by modified smooth cells and normal glomus body cells, usually present with a small mass occurring in the soft tissue or dermis of an extremity, especially in the subungual region. However, other unusual sites, such as the respiratory tract, have also been reported. They are usually sporadic. Their imaging findings are usually nonspecific and likely to appear as a well-delineated round mass

METHODS: We studied the histopathological and immunohistochemical results of 2 cases with **bronchial glomus tumor**. One **case** was diagnosed by bronchoscopic biopsy, and another by surgery. We searched Wanfang, VIP, CNKI and PubMed database for related articles with key word "**bronchial glomus tumor**" both in English and in Chinese for **literature review**.

A glomus tumor is a rare neoplasm arising from the glomus body and mainly found under the nail, on the fingertip or in the foot. They account for less than 2% of all soft tissue tumors. The majority of glomus tumors are benign, but they can also show malignant features. Glomus tumors were first described by Hoyer in 1877 while the first complete clinical description was given by Masson in 1924.

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
