General comments: Authors retrospectively analyzed the clinical, imaging, and histopathological findings of 14 patients with UESL treated in the Shengjing Hospital of China Medical University. The article is informative and well presentation. The reviewer has minor comments. Comments 1) The quality of logic and presentation of the key idea are not good. The importance and new insight of this work are not impression compared with previous studies. 2) On the section of Conclusion, the main findings, limitations, and authors' recommendations should be present more clearly and comprehensively.
