An ERCP is mainly done to **treat a block in a bile or pancreatic duct and to collect samples of cells or tissue**. A duct may become blocked by cancer or from non-cancerous causes such as stones (hard deposits) in the duct. Because an ERCP has a higher rate of serious complications than other endoscopy procedures, it is mainly used for treatment when the bile duct is blocked. It is used less often to make a diagnosis or to check for a problem in the ducts. Imaging tests that are less invasive an...
