Specific Comments to Authors: The manuscript "Gastrointestinal tract injuries after thermal ablative therapies for hepatocellular carcinoma. Case report and review of the literature" showed us an uncommon yet severe complication, thermal damage with GIT injury, and reviewed many associated articles. It suggested clinicians must consider possible complications and accurately weigh up the risks and benefits, choosing the best treatment option not only according to fixed algorithms for HCC, but also tailored to the specific patient. And it is noted that the manuscript needs careful editing by someone with expertise in technical English editing paying particular attention to English grammar, spelling, and sentence structure so that the goals and results of the study are clear to the reader.
