May 31, 2017 · Past heart attack (**myocardial infarction**) A heart attack occurs when an artery that supplies **blood** to the heart muscle gets blocked. The denial of oxygen and nutrients damages the heart's muscle tissue – part of it essentially "dies." The damaged heart tissue does not contract as well, which weakens the heart's ability to pump **blood**.
