Thank you for the opportunity to evaluate the present manuscript. This manuscript is the extensive review of MAFLD in LT. The content of this manuscript is well organised and concise. The authors could mention nearly all aspect of MAFLD in pre-, peri and post LT. Only minor aspect that I would like to suggest; 1. Introduction - line 7-8, the peak age group affected is 45-64.... should be 45-62 years over 40% of people over the age of 60 affected...should be 60 years affected - MAFLD and Trends in Liver Transplantation: the author should added the full name before abbreviation of UNOS/OPTN ; for Scientific Registry of Transplant Recipient (SRTR), the author should mention the full name first before using the abbreviation SRTR as well. 2. *de novo* MALFD --> *de novo* should be in italics and be consistent with italics in all manuscript including the figure 1. 3. As figure 1 the authors also mentioned about genetics, epigenetics, microbiome as factors influencing MAFLD and extra-hepatic malignancy in pre- and post-transplant issues -- the authors should explained the impact of these factors in the main manuscript as well.
