1. General:

2. Abstract:
 - a. I have changed "mastectomy" to "modified radical mastectomy".
 - b. I have changed "TC" to "TC (docetaxel and cyclophosphamide)".
 - c. I have inserted some information regarding sequelae at the end of the "Case Presentation" section.
 - d. I have summarized the conclusion of the abstract.
3. Introduction:

A reference has been inserted in the breast cancer quote in the penultimate sentence of the introduction.
4. Case presentation:
 - a. A sentence of "The patient is right-handed and can write and walk around without crutches and a wheelchair" was added in the first paragraph of the case presentation.
 - b. The endocrine therapy is planned for 5 years, not only for 1 year.
 - c. She received a formal evaluation for radiotherapy in the MDT after surgery.
5. Discussion/conclusion:
 - a. The patient refused breast-conserving surgery and radiotherapy due to differences between Chinese and Western cultures, therefore they finally opted for a modified radical mastectomy.
 - b. The results of the AMOROS clinical trial had not been written into the Chinese guidelines when the patient underwent surgery.
 - c. MDT recommends that she needs adjuvant chemotherapy combined with endocrine therapy, not only endocrine therapy.
