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SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

In this manuscript entitled “Unusual presentation of adult-onset Still’s Disease with liver injury: A case report and review of the literature”, Fan Yu, et al. reported a case of liver injury possibly caused by AOSD. This is an interesting case report with potential clinical impact. Notably, the patient only has symptoms of liver injury, which do not fully meet Yamaguchi’s diagnosis criteria of AOSD. It is understandable that due to the lack of the specific biomarkers and pathological findings for the diagnosis of AOSD, and the difficulties of fully excluding other possible causes of liver injury in this patient, such as autoimmune/inflammatory hepatitis, the authors stated “a presumptive diagnosis of liver injury secondary to AOSD was made”. However, there are multiple overstatements inconsistent with this “presumptive diagnosis” including the title and conclusion which should be addressed. For example, the title could be changed to “An atypical adult-onset Still’s Disease with a sole manifestation of liver injury: A case report and review of the literature”, and in the conclusion and Core tip, "Our study suggests that" should be added in front of “The diagnosis of AOSD should be considered in the case of nonresolving liver injury after the exclusion of common etiologies for liver diseases”.

In the case report and literature review, Dr. Wang and his colleagues reported a rare relapsed AOSD case presenting solely with liver injury. The presumptive diagnosis is mainly based on previous AOSD history and the exclusion of other common, possible liver etiologies. It is interesting case. The title should be revised to " liver injury as initial and solo manifestation of relapsed adult-onset Still's Disease: A case report and review of the literature", which might be more suitable.
