The goal is adapting international guidelines to local context through best decision-makers, avoid duplication of efforts and optimize medical resources. The subject of this manuscript is of value, but there are a few of defects need to be modified.

1. Abstract section: COVID-19 should be defined, including virus caused, etc. 2. The terms about the virus are not uniform in the full text, such as: SARS CoV-2, SARS-CoV-2. It should be uniformly changed to: SARS-CoV-2. Please check and modify. 3. There are a few of grammatical errors in this article. Core tip section: this manuscript content some recommendations about oncological medical treatment of breast cancer in COVID-19.....this should be changed to: This; content should be changed to: contents.....Please check the full text and correct them.
