CBIE acts as the administrator of the sponsorship program on behalf of the said Ministry of Education for the duration of the agreement period, from September 1, 2017 to June 30, 2019, and all funding for the program is the responsibility of the Ministry.

The Ministry pays, on behalf of the student, tuition and all compulsory fees. All other expenses, such as bus or parking passes, health club membership fees, and any other incidental fees, are the sole responsibility of the student and are not to be invoiced to CBIE. Please also note that research expenses are considered separate from mandatory tuition fees and are not covered by this Financial Support Letter. Students sponsored under this program receive a monthly stipend \$3600 payable upon receipt of the budget from Libya, to cover room, board and personal expenses, as well as full medical insurance for themselves and their accompanying family members. Students in academic studies also receive an annual book allowance. This financial support letter is valid only for the specified degree, program, and term(s) indicated above.
