Thank you and the reviewers for the advice and comments on our manuscript "*Twice fertility-sparing surgeries without adjuvant therapy through twice term pregnancies in patient with Low-grade Endometrial Stromal Sarcoma: A case report and literature review*", which was submitted to **World Journal of Clinical cases**. I am appreciated that you gave us opportunity of publication. We considered the reviewer comments and editorial office's comments carefully and revised the paper according to the comments. The following is our answer to the comments.

- Reviewer #1:

MINOR POINTS: In conclusion, the authors mentioned that 'adjuvant therapy may not be necessary'; however, this report is the first attempt of fertility-sparing surgical strategy for LGEES patients with multiple deliveries, so it seemed to be too strong to draw this conclusion through this case report. More modest expression may be appropriate. it should be mentioned, that it is a monocenter study.

To be more modest expression in conclusion, we modified the conclusion part in text "Our case represents the first attempt of fertility-sparing surgery even after two term deliveries and the tumor recurred. We suggested adjuvant therapy may not be necessary but the early reproductive counseling also should be considered as mandatory." into "It seemed that second fertility-sparing surgery could be performed even after two term deliveries and the tumor recurrence. This case also suggested it might be attempted without adjuvant therapy but the early reproductive counseling also should be considered as mandatory."

To emphasis it is a moncenter study, we added "Moreover, large-scale studies with long term follow-up are required to confirm this approach." in the conclusion.

In addition, we also changed the conclusion part in abstract. The former expression was "This case represents the first attempt of fertility-sparing surgery even after two term delivery and the tumor recurred and an attempt of no adjuvant endocrine therapy for the young patient with LGEES." The revised expression is "For the young patient with stage I LGEES, it seems that repeated fertility-sparing surgery could be performed even after two term deliveries and the tumor recurrence, and it might be attempted without adjuvant therapy but the counseling should be considered as mandatory."

The title of the manuscript is too long and must be shortened to meet the requirement of the journal (Title: The title should be no more than 18 words).

Yes. We knew the title should be no more than 18 words. In the revised title, we changed the title “Twice fertility-sparing surgeries without adjuvant therapy through twice term pregnancies in patient with Low-grade Endometrial Stromal Sarcoma: A case report and literature review” into “Fertility-sparing surgeries without adjuvant therapy through term pregnancies in patient with Low-grade Endometrial Stromal Sarcoma: A case report and literature review”. However, it still doesn't meet that requirement. I am so sorry but the name of the disease (Low-grade Endometrial Stromal Sarcoma) is too long to reduce the words.

According to the comments and our answers, we submitted a new revised

manuscript in which we mentioned that it is a monocenter study and more modest expression in the conclusion. The major of the revisions were marked with yellow color. If you have any questions, Please let me know.
