No interaction was observed between **alcohol drinking** and **sex**, family history, and smoking, but the **association with alcohol drinking** was appreciably stronger in the elderly and in less-educated individuals. Thus this large data set was able to exclude a strong and consistent **association between alcohol** (mainly wine) **drinking** and stomach cancer risk.
