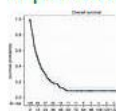

In general, the squamous cell carcinoma survival rate is very high —when detected early, the five-year survival rate is 99 percent. Even if squamous cell carcinoma has spread to nearby lymph nodes, the cancer may be effectively treated through a combination of surgery and radiation treatment.

Approximately 2% to 5% of patients with primary squamous cell carcinoma of the head and neck region will present with cervical adenopathy as the primary disease manifestation; about 10% of this group will present with bilateral adenopathy.

BACKGROUND

Cancer of unknown primary (CUP) is by definition a histological proven malignant tumor whose origin cannot be detected despite careful examination. Most cervical lymph node metastases in CUP (80%) will originate from head and neck sites and 15% show infiltration of squamous carcinoma cells. The survival rates of CUP are poor: 5-

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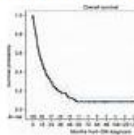
