Intussusception (in-tuh-suh-SEP-shun) is a serious condition in which part of the intestine slides into an adjacent part of the intestine. This "telescoping" often blocks food or fluid from passing through. Intussusception also cuts off the blood supply to the part of the intestine that's affected, which can lead to a tear in the bowel (perforation), infection and death of bowel tissue. Medical Condition

Intestinal obstruction in which one segment of intestine folds into the adjacent portion the intestine



Intestinal obstruction that results when a part of the intestine folds into a section next to it.

Rare (Fewer than 200,000 cases per year in US)

Requires lab test or imaging

Treatment from medical professional advised

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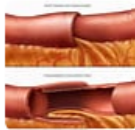

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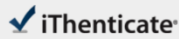

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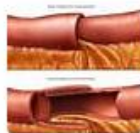
