"Introduction" section, "a stabilization of the incidence in most but also suggest an increase in northern European countries." 2-4 On the other hand, there is a trend of increasing incidence in areas with traditionally lower incidence rates, such as the countries of eastern Europe" The incidence of IBD in western European and North American countries should be reported. 2. "Methods" section, the criteria of IBD should be reported. 3. "Results" section, the total patients and UC, CD, IC demographic data should be reported, including risk factors and co-morbidity. 4. "Results" section, a logistic regression analysis was preferred to analyze the risk factors of IBD.
