I would like to appreciate the author for this extensive review of this pertinent topic. It needs minor modifications to make it better manuscript. I suggest the title be modified to "Ejaculatory dysfunction in men with diabetes mellitus" In third line of abstract, word "currently" is repeated in the sentence which can be deleted. Abbreviation AE can be used for anejaculation throughout manuscript "hypogonadism" typo in page 11 Page 19, DM has to be removed from sentence "However, the fertilization rate and high-quality embryo rate in diabetic patients DM are lower than non-diabetic patients" Page 21, "DM type I" can be modified to "type I DM" Page 21, the sentence "It was concluded that correction of RE in DM1 patients could be achieved with endourethral injection of collagen type 2" is to be modified. What is DM1? Page 22 "was" can be introduced as "The average live birth rate/transfer was 28%" The last sentence of conclusion to be grammatically modified. May I suggest to modify the words "diabetic patient" across the manuscript to "diabetes patient"
