SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

1) Title is very uninformative and the reader cannot be sure what is the purpose of the article 2) Abstract should contain the description of the article type - in this case it is a narrative review. 3) Genetics - authors should mention the current discussion about the penetrance, which may be lower than typically believed 100%, thus increasing the prevalence of asymptomatic forms (see Eur J Clin Invest. 2019 Aug; 49(8): e13147. Published online 2019 Jun 20. doi: 10.1111/eci.13147) 4) Authors should briefly also mention epigenetic alterations which may influence phenotype of the disease 5) Diagnosis - "Free copper" - at first appearance of this term, it should be explained that it is non-ceruloplasmin (albumin bound) copper, since truly free molecular copper is not present in the plasma 6) consider changing very categorical statement about immunological determination of ceruloplasmin, when discussing the calculation of free copper. (E.g. It is preferable to use enzymatically determined ceruloplasmin levels when calculating free copper). Also maybe a wider discussion about poor correlation between ceruloplasmin levels and ceruloplasmin activity can be included - e.g. PMID: 15614251 DOI: 10.1016/j.lab.2004.08.005 7) Some efficacy data for DPA and trientine may be included - e.g. DOI: 10.1016/j.cgh.2013.03.012
