The Authors report a case of a patient undergoing surgery for lumbar spondylolisthesis, experiencing DVT associated to May-Thurner Syndrome. The Article is well written and the topic, given the rarity of this syndrome, it arouses some interest. It seems that the MTS is underestimated and being aware of this possibility is useful in clinical practice. The MTS should be explained in better detail, not only in the discussion but also in the introduction of the article.
