1. References have been updated as requested. In particular, both ref. # 1 and ref. # 3 have been substituted with more recent ones and some old ones were deleted.

*Reviewer # 00289422:*

1. Both sentences have been rephrased in the description of the case.
2. Imaging clues for the differential diagnosis between internal hernias and small bowel volvulus at CT have been described and a reference has been added (# 11) in

the discussion.

3. The last sentence has been deleted.
4. Findings that underscore the originality of the case were already mentioned in the last but one paragraph of the discussion and have not been modified.
5. The legend of Figure 2 (ex Fig. 1) has been changed as suggested.

**Reviewer # 00289479:**

1. The abdominal plain film was performed in the upright position as specified in the description of the case.
2. The upright plain abdominal film performed in the AP projection has been added. However, we don't feel it provides any additional information.
3. Unfortunately, CT scout views are not available.
4. The difficulty of a pre-operative diagnosis has been elucidated as requested.
