**Specific Comments to Authors:** This manuscript introduced a rare complication caused by a foreign body, and I really appreciate your work for reminding that foreign body can cause serious consequences. This paper introduces the causes of delayed pseudoaneurysm formation in detail, and remind us that it is very difficult to detect or identify a wooden material penetrating an area around the neck by using plain x-ray and conventional radiogram. Despite these merits, I still hope the authors can discuss more different complications of trauma caused by a foreign body, and if possible, the authors can introduce the role of surgical navigation technology for foreign body removal.

**Answer:** In addition to the complications caused by this report, various complications such as arteriovenous fistula and infection may occur. Surgery is the basis of treatment because most foreign substances complications are difficult to respond to medical treatment. For surgical treatment, complete removal of foreign body will be the first priority, and the removal of surrounding inflammatory tissue is essential. In addition, the role of an experienced vascular surgeon is very important because in case of suspected vascular damage, vascular bypass or vascular interposition may be necessary in addition to the primary suture of the damaged vessel.
