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#### **SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS**

The authors of the submitted case report intend to document the second case of follicular lymphoma occurring in the renal pelvis. The following points are suggested for further consideration. Major concern: 1. Please discuss how to exclude the possibility of a metastatic lesion in the discussion section based upon the clinical survey for the patient. 2. A higher HE magnification (Fig. 3A) would be needed to demonstrate the dysplastic features of the tumor cells more clearly to the readers. Minor concerns: 1. In the first paragraph of the discussion section, the authors state "Primary renal pelvis and ureteral lymphomas are extremely rare, and only a few cases have been reported in the literature." This sentence needs adequate citations. 2. For the first sentence (line 114) of the fourth paragraph of the discussion section, 'Follicular lymphoma (FL)' has already been defined before. It appears not necessary to repeat the writing as 'Follicular lymphoma (FL)'.
