1. There are some typos in the article, such as "summery", "Miinireview", should it be "summary" and "Minireview"? In my view, M:F=1:9 is better than M:F:1:9. 2. The sample format of Figure 1 is a bit messy and I can not read it clearly. In my view, a picture of Figure with a high resolution will be better in the word app. 3. The table in the article should be a three-line table. 4. The abbreviation of WS appeared in the title of Figure 1, and the full name of WS was suggested. 5. It is said that wandering spleen was first described by Van Horne in 1667 in this review, and the reference for this point should be provided. 6. The number of references in the past five years is a bit small. 7. There is few contents in the section of Introduction, and it should be more detailed and overviewed. 8. The section of Conclusions just summarized the meanings listed in the article, however, the original opinions of all the authors presented in this review will be great for writing this article.
