In this review, Uhl et al explain in detail about gastric MALT lymphomas. Although the authors claim that their manuscript was reviewed by native English speaker, there are many sections where the meaning of the sentence is unnatural (e.g. P.3L.1-4, P.7.L.12, P.8L.2, P.8L.24, etc.).
