The topic is within the scope of the WJH. (1) Classification: Two Grades B; (2) Summary of the Peer-Review Report: The authors have presented significant insights and data that support the role of contrast-enhanced ultrasonography in HCC treatment. The questions raised by the reviewers should be answered; (3) Format: There are 3 figures; (4) References: A total of 53 references are cited, including 17 references published in the last 3 years; (5) Self-cited references: There are 6 self-cited references. The self-referencing rates should be less than 10%.
