The topic is within the scope of the WJH. (1) Classification: Grade C; (2) Summary of the Peer-Review Report: The authors presents a review about sdPSC (Small duct primary sclerosing cholangitis) literature using Pubmed searches and cross-referencing to compile all accessible studies regarding cohorts of sdPSC patients in order better characterize the subset of sdPSC patients who progress to ldPSC (large duct primary sclerosing cholangitis) and the associated outcomes. It is well written and structured. However, the questions raised by the reviewer should be answered; and (3) Format: There is 1 table and 1 figures (4) References: A total of 42 references are cited, including 3 references published in the last 3 years; (5) Self-cited references: There are no self-cited references; and (6) References recommend: The authors have the right to refuse to cite improper references recommended by peer reviewer(s), especially the references published by the peer reviewer(s) themselves.
