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SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This case report raises the possibility that quetiapine is associated with lung injury. The authors did not mention the work-up made (diagnostic tests) to rule out other causes (infectious?). In the discussion, the authors do not turn our attention to previous relevant findings. They should have cited important reports on interstitial lung disease secondary to quetiapine (such as Kim SJ et al. Respiratory Care 2014; 59 (10) e145-e148).
