Abstract

Malignancies constitute the second cause of death in patients with inflammatory bowel diseases (IBD), after cardiovascular diseases. Although it has been postulated that IBD patients are at a greater risk of colorectal cancer compared to the general population, lately there has been evidence supporting that this risk is diminishing overtime as a result of better surveillance, while extra-intestinal cancers (EICs) incidence is raising. This could be attributed either to the systemic inflammation caused by IBD or to the long-lasting immunosuppression due to the IBD treatments. It seems that the overall

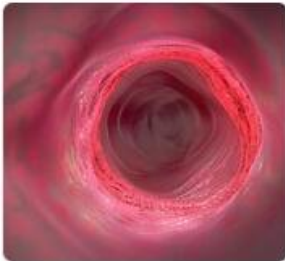
