Grassi et al. reported some issues of endoscopy in cirrhotic patients. The minireview is well written and spots a highlight on some points that lack an evidence-based that needs more researches and randomized controlled clinical trials. The title reflects the main subject of the manuscript. The abstract reflects the work described in the manuscript. The keywords reflect the focus of the manuscript. The manuscript appropriately cites the latest and important references. The presented figures are clear. Language is acceptable but needs some revision. Minor comments: - Page 6-8, under the title "colorectal cancer screening"..... a very long one paragraph. Please reformat. - Page 7: "Liver cirrhosis represented and important contributing factor..."..... correct to "Liver cirrhosis represented an important contributing factor...." - Page 8, 2nd paragraph: "..... but at the same time, an increased risk of significant complications (kidney dysfunction and GI bleeding) in the 30 days following endoscopy"..... please rephrase—no verb in the sentence. -Figure 1: the title "Some tips to consider while approaching cirrhotic patients with gastro-intestinal endoscopy, are reported in the figure."..... Please modify to "Some tips to consider while approaching cirrhotic patients with gastrointestinal endoscopy".
