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SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

Blastic plasmacytoid dendritic cell neoplasm (BPDCN) is a very rare hematological malignancy with a highly aggressive nature. The authors experienced three cases of this rare tumor and wrote a case report with a short review. My opinion is that this paper is concisely well written and informative. Based on that, I request the authors to consider my suggestions below. 1. (Abstract) In the METHODS, it is described that the study subjects were three cases. However, Case 3 is not described at all in the RESULTS and CONCLUSION. Something should be mentioned on Case 3. 2. (Case presentation & Discussion) Chemotherapeutic regimens, such as CHOP, VDLD, CAM, and VDCLP, are described without explanations. It would be better to explain these regimens at their first appearance.
