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SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

In this manuscript, the authors report a new and interesting case of intestinal intussusception caused by intestinal duplication and ectopic pancreas. This is a quite well-written manuscript and the authors have made a respectable effort. The discussion of this manuscript is quite short. the authors must precise the number of cases of intestinal intussusception caused by intestinal duplication and ectopic pancreas seperately. The quality of figure 1 must be improved (SHADES OF GRAY) and the legend should be more precise, for instance the authors must precise the difference between Figure 1A, Figure 1B, Figure 1C and Figure 1D The legend of figure 5 should be corrected : In fact the red arrow indicates the pancreatic duct and the green arrow indicates the pancreatic acinus. The references are not recent enough English language editing is mandatory
