- (4) Comment by reviewer: "The section of functional dyspepsia and GERD could be expended to further discuss the recent studies and meta-analyses."
- The section titled functional dyspepsia/GERD has been expanded as suggested by the reviewer.
- (5) Comment by reviewer: "The title is too ambitious compared with the topics actually stressed."
