The paper is well written, easy to read and well structured. I have a few comments though to the authors. First of all, please specify why the patient interrupted dabigatran within 4 days prior hospital admission. Secondly, it is not clear if the authors tried to performe endoscopic hemostasis. Please clarify and specify what type of hemostasis did you performed. I think it is important to underline this fact in order to have a complete algorithm of diagnosis and management of GI bleeding.
