The abstract summarize and reflect the work described in the manuscript. Key words reflect the focus of the manuscript. The manuscript adequately describe the background, present status and significance of the study, but let me say that the background could be more explained to make clear, why it is important to occupy with your topic. Methods (patients, research methods, statistical analysis) are also described very shortly, but they are explained enough to know what you did.
