Prostate cancer has no obvious symptoms in the early stages. As the disease progresses, it gradually causes oppressive or metastatic symptoms. Transurethral insertion of an electron microscope was used to remove the protruding part of the prostate. Due to the pain caused by the surgical trauma, psychological pressure, economic burden, and other factors may affect the treatment effect, making it difficult for the patient to adhere to treatment. It is necessary for medical staff to provide reasonable nursing measures to assist the patient complete treatment and improve their prognosis. In this study, the authors investigated the effects of nursing combined with bladder function training based on Peplau's interpersonal relationship theory on the incidence of postoperative urinary incontinence. The manuscript is well written, and the results are very interesting. Comments: 1. The title is too long, the authors should short the title for less than 20 or 18 words. 2. A conclusion should be added to the main text. 3. The tables should be edited and moved to the end of the manuscript. 4. There are some minor language polishing, which should be revised.
