I have the following comments: 1. Minor editing and language corrections are necessary. We highlighted some of the words or sentences in yellow color in the main file that need revision. 2. The title should be written as "The effects of COVID-19 on the liver: A single-center experience." 3. Abstract: please separate the background from the aim as per journal style. 4. Please add another keyword to be 6 as per journal style. 5. Please reduce the core tip to up to 100 words as per journal style. 6. Introduction: Although the descriptive part is satisfactory, there is no challenging part. 7. MATERIALS AND METHODS: a. You didn't mention the exclusion criteria. b. Please, move table 1 to the results section. c. Confirmation of the diagnosis of COVID-19 is confusing for the readers, please take care of this point. d. "The data collected were independently reviewed by experienced physicians." This sentence is not clear, did you mean all the authors or what?. e. P at < 0.05 (not ≤ 0.05) is considered a statistically significant difference. 8. Results a. You said a lot of numbers in the first 5 paragraphs of the text without refereeing to any table. b. We found that there is a repetition like "In general, ALT was found to be elevated in 603 of our patients". Please try to avoid unnecessary repetition. c. Table 2 indicates that there is no negative impact of abnormal liver function tests on the severity of COVID-19. This is opposite to your conclusion. 9. References: a. The references should follow the journal style. For example, you didn't bold the name of the first author as well as you must add the PIMD for each article. b. Please re-write reference number 39, taking into consideration of the following publication journal. Please the link see



https://pubmed.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/32645044/. 10. Other notes I highlighted in yellow color in the main manuscript file.
