SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This is an interesting study, but I have some comments: 1) it is not indicated for which period the mortality was estimated, there is no standard analysis of the significance of the difference in mortality (Kaplan-Meier estimator), there is no multivariate Cox regression in the analysis of mortality; 2) patients with concomitant hepatitis B and C should be excluded from the study, as these conditions also contribute to the clinical course of the disease.
