Reviewer #1 (Remarks to the Author):

The limitations are well pointed out, but even within the same institution, the results could have been different depending on the competence of the endoscopists performing the procedure.

**Response:** As you noted, different endoscopic operators will get different results, which is inevitable. Even though the endoscopic operators in our center are all skilled endoscopists, we hope to conduct a multi-center study with a large sample size for verification in the future.

Also, in the conclusion, DM was used as a significant predictor, but in the

table, the calculation guidance should have been 50%, but it was incorrectly shown as 0.5, so it will be important to check if it is actually correct.
