SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

The authors of the article beautifully and systematically presented the complex issue of *Helicobacter pylori* infection as a systemic infection that can have negative consequences on the course of pregnancy. They also presented the possibilities of her diagnosis and therapy depending on the semester of pregnancy. The decision on eradication during and after pregnancy is individual. It would be best for planned pregnancies to check the individual status of *Helicobacter pylori* before potential conception, and to carry out eradication before pregnancy
