Was there histology performed after removal? Histological evaluation of the specimen is a standard procedure. -Please expand the literature in the discussion section. Some of the possible articles can be borrowed from a similar case report of an abdominal wall pericytoma (Shabunin et al. of Surgical treatment patient with hemangiopericytomaand abdominoplasty: a clinical case; 2023/38 (4): 166-169). Please add and discuss the criteria of malignancy for solitary fibrous tumor. Please analyze the metastatic pathway of



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dissemination in this case. Please take into account the recommendations in the spirit of improving the quality of the submission.
