Specific Comments to Authors: Comments: In this retrospective study, the authors evaluate the role of pediatric T-tube in adult OLT. In this study, 72 patients were included and outcomes were evaluated. Abstract: Written well. Few grammatical errors exist, which needs attention. Introduction: Written well. Methods: T-tube insertion protocol could be in the supplementary section. Image describing the procedure is adequate. Same holds good for the T-tube removal procedure. Discussion and limitations were mentioned appropriately. Overall well informed manuscript.

Response: we thank the reviewer for their comments and suggestions.
