

This mini-review article reviewed indications and outcomes of liver transplantation in patients with benign liver tumors which are quite rare. This is indeed remarkable that this topic is limited to case reports or small case series as the authors mentioned. There are several minor comments; -Can the authors mention little bit more about living donor liver transplantation? Due to organ shortage, especially in Asian countries, there are some cases, of course not many, of living donor liver transplantation in these benign liver tumor patients. -Can the authors update the references? Most of the references are before 2015. I understand that reports dealing with long-term outcomes inevitably are before 2015s, but still more recent references are required to increase the value of this paper.

We would like to thank the reviewers for their valuable comments. In response to their comments, we have added a paragraph on living donor living transplantation for benign living tumors and we agree that this issue bears importance because of specific aspects of deceased donor transplantation for benign lesions with preserved liver function in the era of organ shortage. Also, we added 4 references, two of them are more recent in response to the comment about including more recent references. Finally, English language was edited again and some minor corrections were made.
