The authors described a very interesting case report of a 27-year-old female with T-lymphoblastic lymphoma suffering from extensive thrombi, including a large right atrial thrombus. The patient was first treated with low-dose dexamethasone and low-molecular-weight heparin followed by 2 cycles of chemotherapy (liposomal doxorubicin) with the addition of chidamide. The patient survived for 6 months. I recommend to do a table for the explanation of the therapy and another table showing Patient results, to clarify those points.
