Congratulations for the innnovative work that have been done by the authors. I would like to suggest the following modifications/additions in the paper: 1) Apply Prisma 2020 checklist and their statements in the methodology. 2) Sentence starting on the line 78-79 was not clear to me. I suggest rewrite. 3) Line 99, I presume the word "cursed" was wrong. I correct word would be "curve". 4) Lines 159-160, the authors have included the results from the article of Shigefuku. The meta-analisys must have more than 1 article to analyse an effect size I think this sentence would be better placed in the discussion. The effect size "CSS" studied by the authors has only 1 article. So, I suggest to exclude CSS of the objective of the present study.
