However, some minor language polishing should be revised. And the manuscript requires a carefully editing. Such as, abstract – purpose – "the family of (CBA) children with biliary atresia.", this sentence should be "the family of children with CBA."; abstract – results – " (P=0.000, 0.000)", what's the mean of this? Please check and make a revision or make a clarify, and also, some Chinese comma in the main text and tables should be revised.
