The study addresses a very interesting topic and deals with a major concern for investigators who have to perform a meta-analysis from published studies. Methodology appears to be accurate. The presentation of the results is clear, although it may be simplified for a general (non-expert) reader, who might be interested in such a current topic. Figure 1 and 2 should be redrawn. Lines should be identified with different patterns. English style and grammar need to be revised in depth.

REPLY: We thank the Reviewer for his/her suggestion. We have now simplified the results to better clarify our conclusion to non-expert reader.

Figures 1 and 2, in the supplemental material files, show the standardized estimates of each distribution and of each imputation method we considered. Each method is depicted with a different color. In our opinion this should suffice to clearly identify each line. We think that further redraw, including a different symbol for each line, risks to confound the reader.

The manuscript has been carefully reviewed by an English native speaker.

It is a valuable contribution. There are language errors scattered across the manuscript - typing errors, spelling errors, occasionally grammatical and syntax errors. I suggest that you should carefully read the manuscript or consult an English editor. I have no essential comments or remarks on the topic, methods or results presentation.
