Please notify us if you are unable to provide the requested information within this time frame.

We will be posting the title and synopsis of your successful grant on our website in the near future, as well as in the ADS News. In addition to your 6 monthly reports, it is a requirement of accepting this grant is that you send a report of 1-2 A4 pages outlining the outcomes at the conclusion of your project. This may be published on the ADS website, newsletter and Annual Report. The ADS will also provide a copy to Servier. It is expected that you will present your findings at the ADS Annual Scientific Meeting in 2017.

Congratulations again on the success of your application and we are very grateful to Servier who provided the funds for these grants. We look forward to receiving your instructions for payment of the funds shortly.
