All the improved parts were written in red letters.

- (1) The combination is safe only in Child A because Asunaprevir is contraindication in decompensated cirrhosis

**Response:** In the section “Materials and methods” we already sited that “of the cirrhotic patients only those with Child-Pugh stage A were enrolled. However, we also added in the Abstract (Method section) the mention “Child B, C cirrhotic patients were excluded”.

- (2) The adverse effects that lead to discontinuation were very high compared to other regimens. Please mention the level of elevation for example (ALT, AST & Bilirubin at which you discontinue the drug). Please add to the table (2)cases which discontinue the drugs but achieved SVR.

**Response:** The levels of elevation of ALT and total bilirubin at which the drug was discontinued; 200 INU (5 folds normal) for ALT and 3.0mg/dl for total bilirubin. We mentioned the statesment in the “Results” (safety section). According to the kind advice of the reviewer, we added to the table(2) cases which discontinue the drugs but achieved SVR.
