On behalf of the Children's Miracle Network Research Review Committee, I am pleased to inform you that your application for "**Genetic Association and Function of the IL10 and IL10 Signaling Pathway in Pediatric Inflammatory Bowel Disease (IBD)**" will receive **\$30,000** in research funding from the 2010 Children's Miracle Network fundraising campaign.

It is the responsibility of the Children's Miracle Network Research Review Committee to designate research funds in accordance with the mission of Children's Miracle Network to improve the quality of life for children in need of medical care at Penn State Hershey Children's Hospital.
