SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This review is very well written, summarizing a wide variety of knowledge and findings regarding the usage of stem cells as a material-delivering tool. I believe that this review will contribute to an advanced understanding of the application of stem cells to diverse



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therapeutic purposes. There are minor grammatical/terminological concerns, which should be addressed before publication in World Journal of Stem Cells. Grammatical/terminological concerns: 1. In line 13 in page 3, the phase "... on the endothelial walls ..." should be corrected as either "... on the endothelial membrane..." or "... on the luminal surface of the vascular walls...", since mammalian cells do not have cell walls. 2. In line 20 in page 6, the word "however" should be replaced by "although". 3. In line 22 in page 6, the comma after the word "conditions" should be deleted. 4. In line 25 in page 7, the word "MSc" should be corrected as "MSC". 5. In line 13 in page 10, commas should be placed before and after the word "however". 6. In line 25 in page 13, the word "co-localise" should be corrected as "co-localize"
